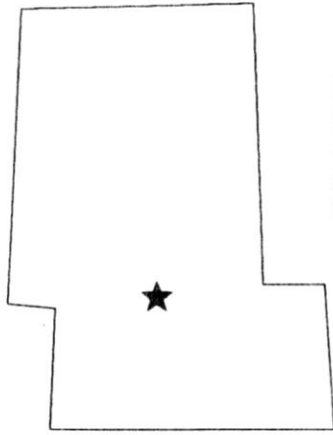

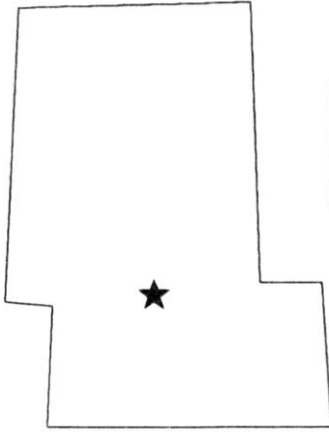

## SOME MORE CALENDAR NOTES

Julian calendar introduced by Julius Caesar - 45 B.C.  
365.25 days per year  
leap year every four years between 23 Feb and 24 Feb  
1st day of year as 25 Mar (from 14th century) in  
error 1 day every 128 years

Gregorian calendar introduced by Pope Gregory XIII - 1582  
slightly less than 365.25 days/year  
leap year every four years using 29 Feb (but not in Century years unless  
divisible by 400)  
1st Jan as first day of the year

Europe adopted the new style calendar first, there was confusion about dates & in Britain the notation 1700/01 was used for the period between 1 Jan & 24 Mar. In early American records there are examples as early as 1699. In Quaker records the dates are given as day, number-of-the-month, year, adding to the confusion. The old Style date, 3rd day of the eleventh month 1700/01 was 3 Jan 1701 in the New Style. March was the first month regardless of the date.

Genealogical problems occur in trying to determine whether the dates are in the Old Style or the New; sometimes when the dates were recorded years after the event (or copied by hand for preservation) after the adoption of the new calendar, the recorder converted to the New.

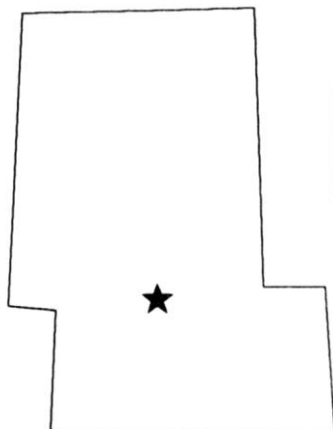

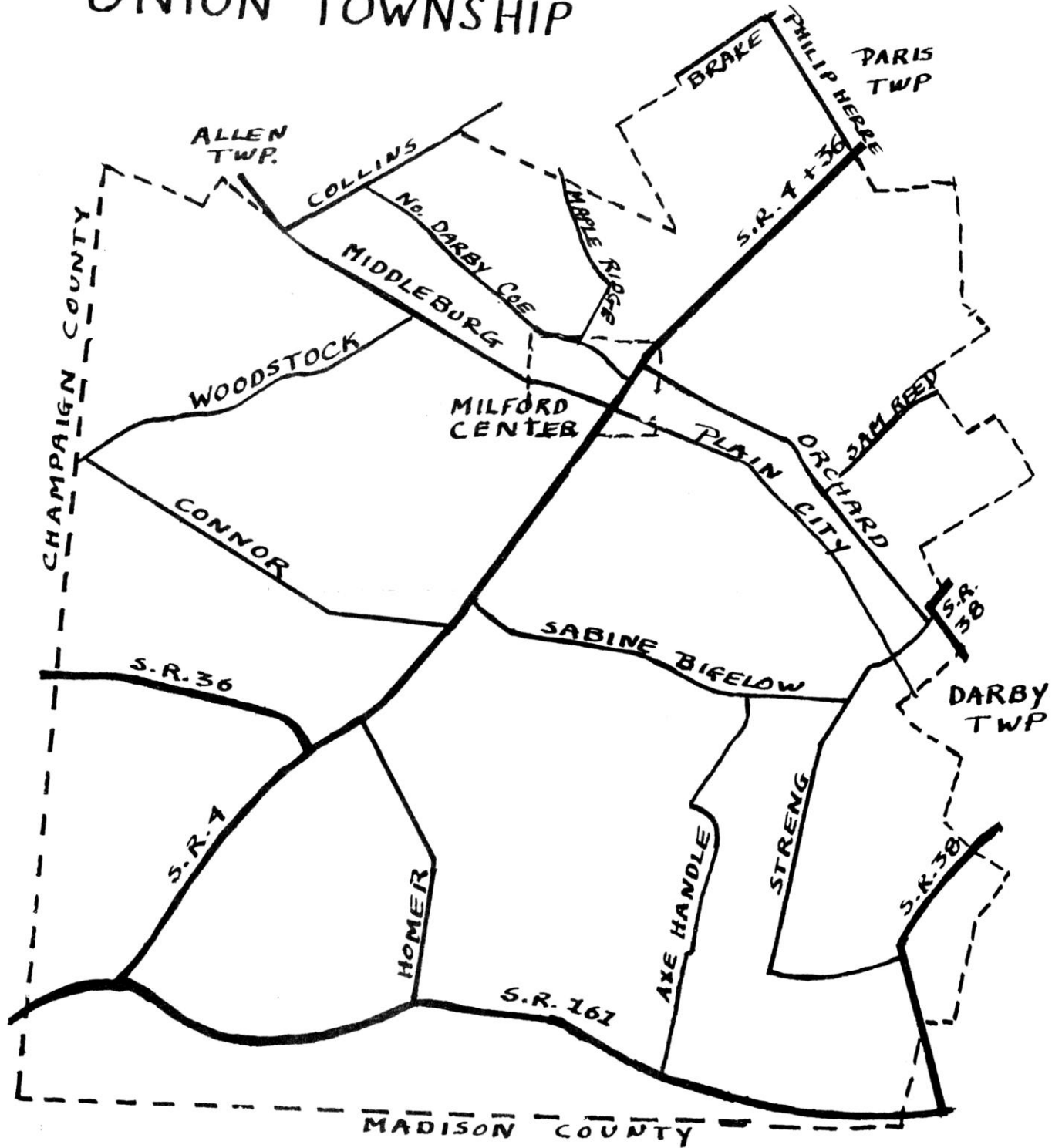

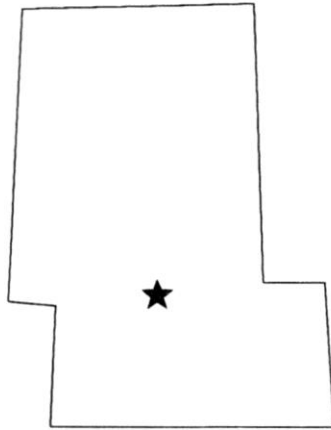

In the May 22, 1991 Patrick M Quinn, University Archivist, Northwestern Univ., published a paper "The Surge of Interest in Genealogy Reflects a Populist Strand in Society With Implications for Our Culture" in which he presents reasons for the surge as viewed by an archivist. In particular, he challenges the positions of the archivist community that genealogical research is trivial and unimportant. He traces interest in genealogy from the Book of Genesis in the Bible to the Industrial Revolution, Dickens' influence through his novels and of course Alex Haley's ROOTS. He argues that in the US, the migratory nature of Americans during the settling of the West led to loss of family linkages - sometimes intentionally - as they struggled to build a new society and a new nation. He also points to the increasing divorce rates today that have further eroded family ties, and the "homogenized society" that was the result of the "melting pot" mind-set since the founding of the US. Now Americans are striving to reclaim those lost threads before they are lost forever. He suggests that in our sometimes tumultuous modern society, a knowledge of one's roots can provide a much needed sense of security.

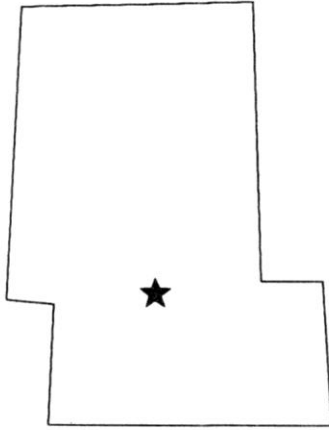

8 April 1861 - John Falk, Esq. duly elected director.

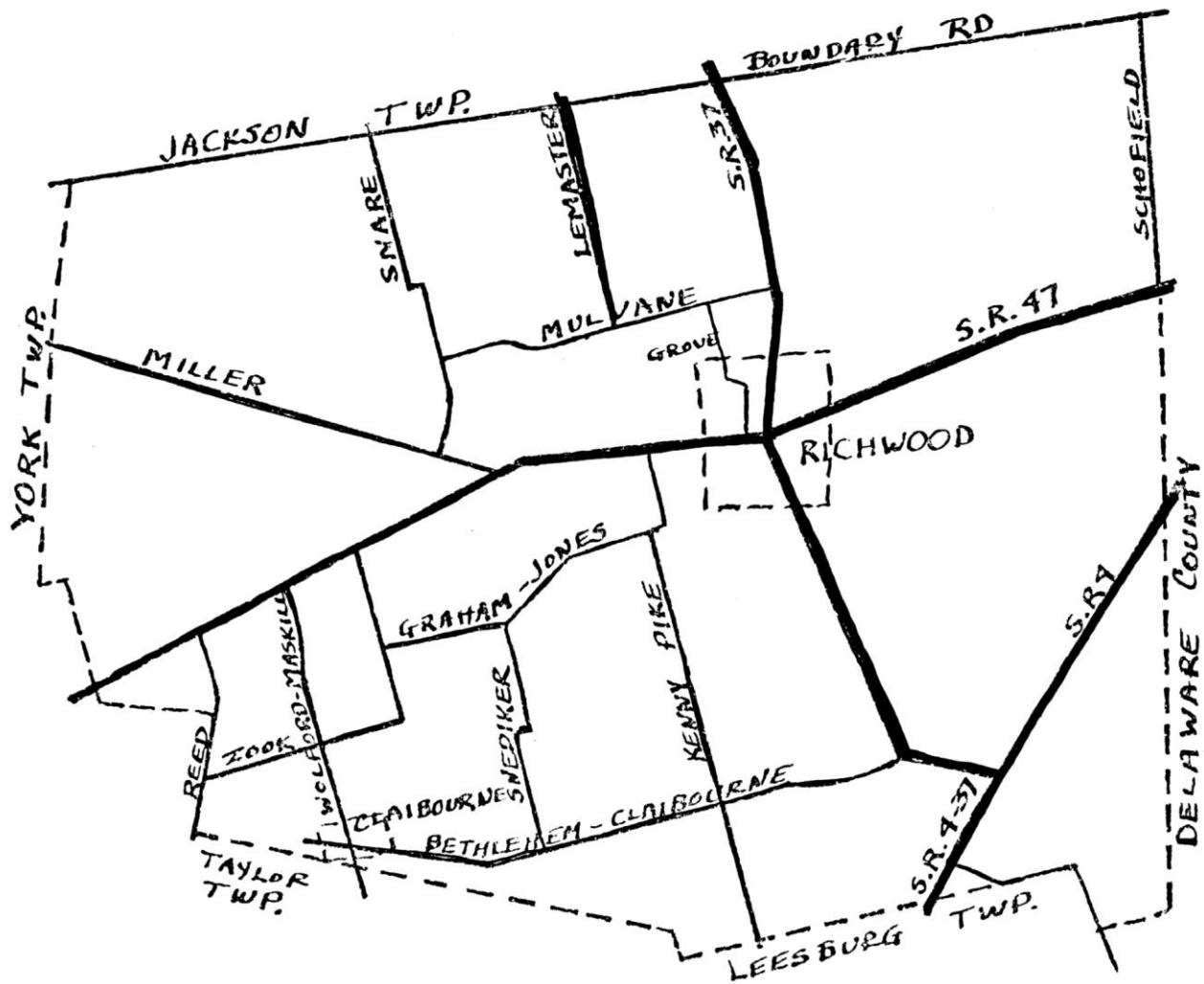

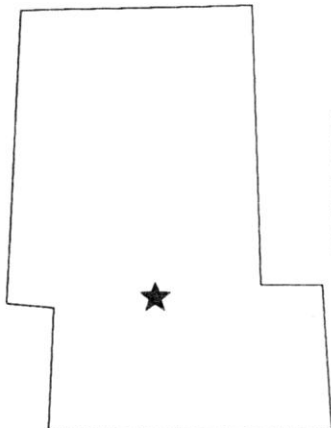

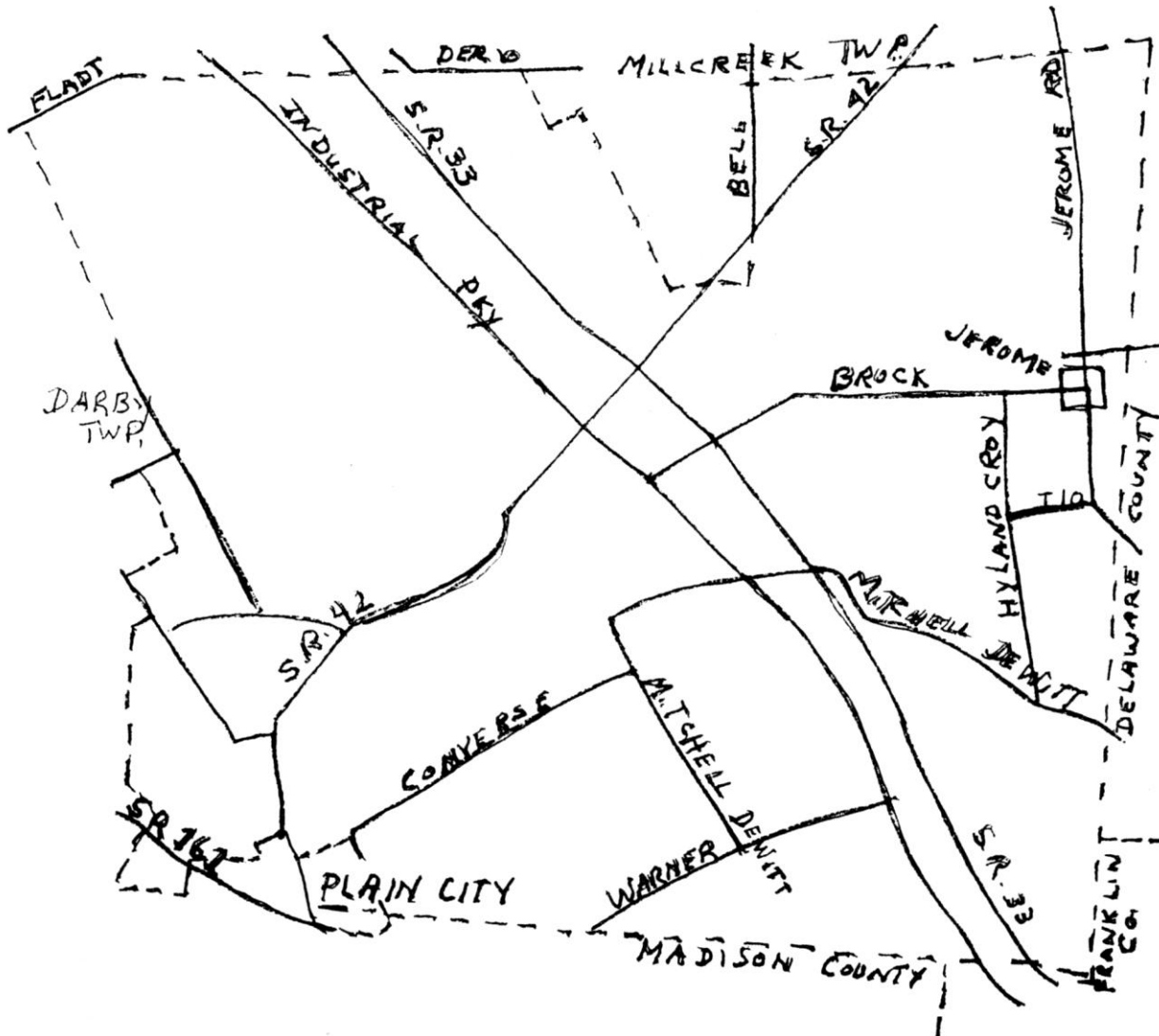
