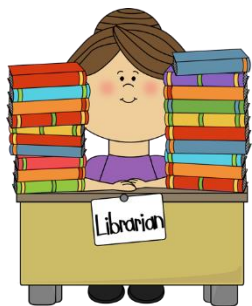

# The Fort Ancient Cemetery Restoration Workshop

Warren County Genealogical Society

## The Fort Ancient Hilltop Cemetery

Turtlecreek Twp, Warren Co., Ohio

The workshop will be held at the cemetery

**Thursday, April 16, 2020, from 9 am to 4 pm**

A picnic lunch will be served mid-day.



We are exceedingly pleased to have **Jonathan Appell** of Gravestone Conservation, West Hartford, CT, leading our hands-on workshop. Topics covered will include how to re-set stones, repair fragmented stones, use of appropriate repair materials, methods of using infill materials, and cleaning and re-pointing masonry. “Since 1987, it has been **Jonathon Appell**’s mission to conserve, preserve, educate and increase public appreciation for the history that can be found in the world’s gravestones, monuments, architecture and sculpture. We have been able to accomplish this in concert with regional and local governments, municipalities, historic trusts, foundations and societies, along with private individuals, heirs and descendants.”

Our workshop will empower participants providing them with the tools they will need to document, preserve, and restore cemeteries and will demonstrate in step-by-step fashion how to preserve and restore cemetery and what laypeople should and should not undertake.

**Restoration techniques demonstrated are guided by standards recommended by NCPTT, the National Center for Preservation and Technology Training.**

This workshop includes extensive, detailed handouts that provide a guide in the right and wrong ways to approach preservation and conservation.

In the workshop, you will learn the basics of gravestone repair and preservation, such as leveling stones, building new bases, repairing broken stones, and properly cleaning grave markers. During the workshop and under the supervision of **Jonathan Appell**, participants will have the opportunity to work on actual grave markers.

The workshop will touch on scientific aspects of the fields of archeology, geology, sociology, plus history and genealogy.

**Directions:** the Fort Ancient Cemetery (aka Bethel Baptist Church Cemetery) is located six (6) miles east of downtown Lebanon, OH on SR-350 and high on the west ridge above the Wild and Scenic Little Miami River.

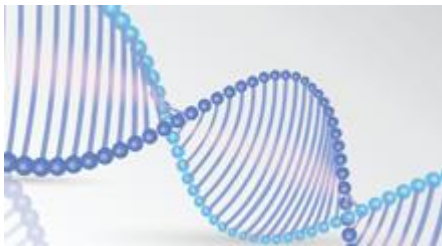

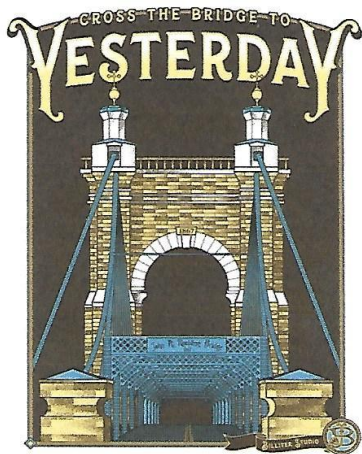

President Rutherford B. Hayes is a distant relative of fellow U.S. Presidents George H.W. Bush and George W. Bush, according to recent genealogy research completed by a Hayes family member and confirmed by the Hayes Presidential Library.

President Hayes also is distantly related to British Prime Minister Boris Johnson.

Hayes family member Theo Hayes completed the family history, and Head Librarian John Ransom verified its accuracy.

“It is unique to have a former president related to not only two U.S. presidents but also a foreign leader that is currently in power,” said Ransom. “Genealogy can hold surprises.
